DECEMBER IMAGINATION



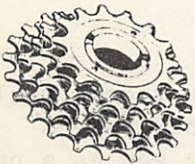

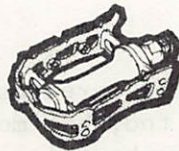
AND THE YEAR TO COME
