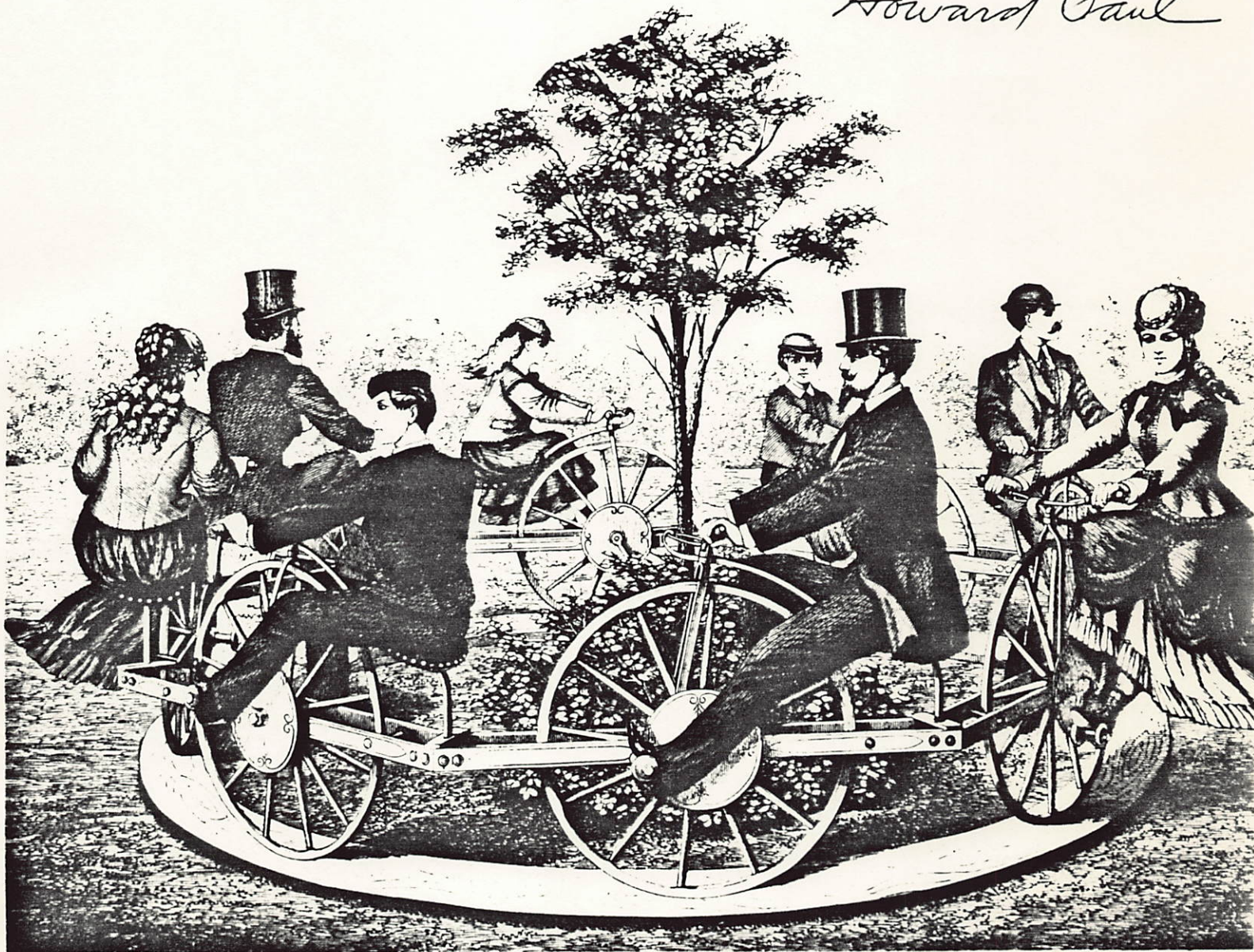


FINAL REPORT
