The tour we are going to do is "The Amazing Lakefront Segway Tour". You can read the locations we'll be seeing.



The meeting was called to order at 7:15 pm

**Harmon Hundred:** Mary Kay reported the preregistrations were down a bit from last year, that we had received approx. \$1000 as of now, with more coming in-usually we receive about \$5000 by the time of the ride; other clubs have reported lower pre-registrations this year as well;

- -Sam's Club does not carry the powdered Gatorade any longer; Johannes agreed to check to see if Costco does, otherwise we would see about an online purchase;
- -Meg reported she has notified our insurance carrier of the ride so we will be covered; we just need to inform them of the count after the ride;

- -Tom will send the routes to Leonard Geis to create the cue sheets;
- -The volunteer pizza party is set for September 10, 2009 at 7:00 pm at Lou Malnati's, cash bar, free for volunteers and \$5.00 for non-volunteers and guests, including spouses and children

**President's Report:** Meg reported she has locked-in Buca Di Beppo for the club banquet, November 8, 2009 at 12:30pm, the gag gifts are being taken care of, Meg needs to order the mileage winner medals;

- -membership is currently 222 registered;
- -discussed the ride line, whether it is needed, whether it was being used and whether the monthly expenses are worth the benefits we get, decided to contact Frank Bing to get his perspective on it;
- -discussed the recognition of rides and excursions, discussed that we would not recognize week-day, multi-day rides other than the excursions included on the ride schedule, and the


