BOARD BANTER

So are you ready to roll?

I've truly enjoyed my "off season" getting in some hiking, x-country skiing, functional training, yoga and yes even some biking both road and trail. But now it is time to turn our focus to the 2015 cycling season. Drum roll please...

Each season, I try to keep a balance of the "tried and true" routes and mixing in some new rides since variety is the spice of life. This year is no different. Some of the highlights include:

- There will be at least one new Sunday short ride added to the mix. It's called "A Touch of Inverness." This route will take you on some roads you know and peppered with some nice neighborhood roads in Inverness you may not know. I'm sure you'll enjoy checking out a new area in Inverness offering quiet roads, nice homes, and a few challenging hills. Be sure to keep your cue sheets handy as there are a few twists and turns.
- In June we will be offering two invitationals that offer club mileage credit. As always the Udder Century, but we've added the BCLC Ramble to the calendar. These clubs have always supported the St Pat's and Harmon, so it is only right we support their invitationals. This also gives you a chance to ride some different roads plus have full SAG support.
- For July we've added a ride called Richmond Antioch Blend. Dan Wiessner and I worked together on this one to come up with a combination of some of the Antioch routes mixed with the Firefighters Fall Fifty ride out of Richmond. Here's an opportunity to try some parts of Steele and Knob that you haven't ridden before. Bring your climbing gears for this one. The route is still being tweaked but looks like it will be around 80 miles.
- Then in August there's

an addition to the Honey Do ride. For this one Saturday you will have the option to do the Honey Do, Extended Do or a Double Metric Century. The way you will get 124 miles is to do the Extended Do out to Veteran's Park in McHenry, then pick up the 50 mile route of the Geneva Lite ride. That will take you out to Lake Geneva and back to Veteran's Park. From there you'll continue on the Extended Do route. What's nice about this is that you can decide at Veteran's Park if you have the legs to make it to Lake Geneva and back or just finish the Extend Do route for just 72 miles.

This year in September
the Honey Do will start
at 9am instead of 8am.
With our unpredictable
weather, an hour can
mean temperatures
several degrees warmer. Reminders will
come out in late August
so no worries.
